## Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to amend the *Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order (No 2) 2021* to provide that a person is not required to electronically register contact details when entering retail premises within a shopping centre if the person provided the details when entering the shopping centre.

### **1 Name of Order**

This Order is the *Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order (No 2) Amendment (No 4) 2021*.

### **2 Commencement**

This order commences at the beginning of 27 December 2021.

### **3 Amendment of Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order (No 2) 2021**

#### **Clause 10 Registration of contact details for entry to certain premises**

Insert before clause 10(4)(a)—

(a1) a person—

- (i) entering retail premises contained within, and only accessible through, a shopping centre, and
- (ii) who provided the person's details when entering the shopping centre,
