Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to amend the *Public Health (COVID-19 Self-Isolation) Order (No 2) 2022* to reduce the period during which certain household contacts of a person diagnosed with COVID-19 are exempt from the requirement to self-isolate.

1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Public Health (COVID-19 Self-Isolation) Order (No 2) Amendment (No 1) Order 2022*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences at the beginning of 12 July 2022.

3 Amendment of Public Health (COVID-19 Self-Isolation) Order (No 2) 2022

(1) Clause 10 Exemption in certain other circumstances

Omit “12 weeks” from clause 10(b). Insert instead “4 weeks”.

(2) Clause 11 Persons who reside with diagnosed persons

Omit “12 weeks” from the note to the clause. Insert instead “4 weeks”.
