**Commencement**

**1.** This Regulation commences on 21 March 1990.

**Amendment**

**2.** The Building Services Corporation Regulation 1990 is amended by inserting after clause 26 the following clause:

**Refund of fees**

26A. (1) The Corporation may refund the whole or any part of the relevant fee if;

- (a) an application for an authority or permit, or for the renewal or restoration of an authority or permit, is refused or withdrawn; or
- (b) an authority is surrendered; or
- (c) an application to sit for an examination conducted by or on behalf of the Corporation or for the re-mark of the result

of such an examination is refused or withdrawn or an applicant does not attend for such an examination.

- (2) Any such refund is to be paid to:
  - (a) the applicant for or the holder of the authority or permit; or
  - (b) the applicant for the examination or the re-mark; or
  - (c) any other person who appears to the Corporation to be entitled to the refund.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Building Services Corporation Regulation 1990 to provide for the refund of application or examination fees in certain specified circumstances.
