**Commencement**

1. This Regulation commences on 3 June 1990.

**Amendments**

2. Schedule 1 to the Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985 is amended:

- (a) by deleting the word "Fenetylline" and by inserting instead the word "Fenethylline"; and
- (b) by inserting in alphabetical order the following matter:

N-acetylamphetamine	3.0g	1.0g	5.0g	250.0g	1.0kg
N-acetylmethylamphetamine	3.0g	1.0g	5.0g	250.0g	1.0kg
N-formylamphetamine	3.0g	1.0g	5.0g	250.0g	1.0kg
N-formylmethylamphetamine	3.0g	1.0g	5.0g	258.0g	1.0kg

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985 so as:

- (a) to add to the Schedule of prohibited plants or drugs certain substances found as intermediate products in the manufacture of amphetamine and methylamphetamine; and
  - (b) to substitute the preferred form of spelling for a substance already appearing in the Schedule.
