(Relating to offences involving ski-frees)

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 25 June 1990.

Amendment

2. The Maritime Services (Short Description of Offences) Regulation 1987 is amended by inserting in Schedule 1 in appropriate order in the matter relating to the Management of Waters and Waterside Lands Regulations - N.S.W. the following matter:

Regulation 19A - use a ski-free on waters specified in the Eighth Schedule to the Regulations use ski-free on prohibited waters

Regulation 19A - navigate a ski-free on waters specified in the Eighth Schedule to the Regulations navigate ski-free on prohibited waters

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe short descriptions for certain offences involving the use of a ski-free so that those descriptions may be used in informations, complaints, summonses, warrants, notices, orders and other documents by virtue of section 145B of the Justices Act 1902.
