**Commencement**

1. This Regulation commences on 25 June 1990.

**Amendment**

2. The Maritime Services (Short Description of Offences) Regulation 1987 is amended by inserting in Schedule 1 in appropriate order in the matter relating to the Management of Waters and Waterside Lands Regulations - N.S.W. the following matter:

Regulation 19A - use a ski-free on waters use ski-free on

Regulations

Regulation 19A - navigate a ski-free on navigate ski-free on  
waters specified in the Eighth Schedule prohibited waters
