The Council of the University of New South Wales, in pursuance of the University of New South Wales Act 1968, makes the following By-law

Chapter 3 of the By-laws made under the University of New South Wales Act 1968 is amended by omitting By-law 10 (3) and by inserting instead the following paragraph:

(3) Neither the President nor the Deputy President is entitled to serve 3 consecutive terms of office.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this By-law is to enable the President of the Academic Board of the University to serve 2 consecutive terms of office (currently the President cannot serve consecutive terms) and to limit the Deputy President to 2 consecutive terms (currently there is no restriction on the number of consecutive terms that the Deputy President can serve).
