Citation

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Children (Interstate Transfer of Offenders) Regulation 1989.

Commencement

2. This Regulation takes effect on 30th June 1990.

Definition

3. In this Regulation:

"**the Act**" means the Children (Interstate Transfer of Offenders) Act 1988.

Transfer legislation enacted by other States

4. For the purposes of section 4(2) of the Act, the States which are declared to have enacted legislation dealing with the interstate transfer of young offenders are set out in Schedule 1.
