LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1919 - ORDINANCE
(Relating to the muzzling of dogs in Council markets)

Commencement

1. This Ordinance commences on 1 July 1990.

Amendment

2. Ordinance No. 65 under the Local Government Act 1919 is amended by inserting after clause 8 (d) the following subclause:

(e) A person, being the owner of a dog or a person in charge or control of a dog, must ensure that the dog is securely muzzled while the dog is in the Council's markets.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Ordinance is to provide that a person who is the owner of a dog or a person in charge or control of a dog must ensure that the dog is securely muzzled while it is in a public cattle market.
