REVENUE LAWS (RECIPROCAL POWERS) ACT 1987 - ORDER

I, Rear Admiral Sir DAVID JAMES MARTIN, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 3 (3) of the Revenue Laws (Reciprocal Powers) Act 1987, do, by this my Order, declare:

- (a) that the law of the Northern Territory described in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order is a recognised revenue law for the purposes of that Act; and
- (b) that the office described in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order is the designated Northern Territory revenue office in respect of the corresponding recognised revenue law described in column 1 of that Schedule; and
- (c) that the office described in column 3 of the Schedule to this Order is the relevant principal New South Wales revenue office in respect of the corresponding recognised revenue law described in column 1 of that Schedule.
