Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 20 July 1990.

Amendment

2. The Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Regulations are amended:
 - (a) by omitting from Regulation 19 (2) the words "determined fee" and by inserting instead the words "fee prescribed in Schedule 0".
 - (b) by inserting after Schedule N the following Schedule:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Regulation fixes fees payable for obtaining information from the records of the Roads and Traffic Authority in connection with motor vehicle third party insurance.
