Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 1 August 1990.

Amendments

2. The Registered Clubs Regulation 1983 is amended:
 - (a) by omitting from clause 8 (5) (b) the words "licensing inspector within whose area of supervision the premises to which the application relates are, or will be, located" and by inserting instead the words "Commissioner of Police";
 - (b) by omitting clauses 24 and 25.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Registered Clubs Regulation 1983 to replace a reference to a licensing inspector with a reference to the Commissioner of Police and to remove provisions relating to licensing inspectors, as a consequence of the enactment of the Registered Clubs (Amendment) Act 1990 which confers functions on the Commissioner of Police rather than licensing inspectors.
