The Maritime Services Board of New South Wales, in pursuance of the Sydney Harbour Trust Act 1900 and the Maritime Services Act 1935, hereby makes the following Regulation:

Commencement

1. This Regulation takes effect on 27 August 1990.

Amendment

2. The Port of Sydney Regulations are amended:
 - (a) by omitting Regulation 75A (a) and by inserting instead the following paragraph:
 - (a) on Mondays to Fridays, inclusive (except on public holidays), at the following times:

10.15 a.m., 11.30 a.m., 1 p.m., 2 p.m., 2.45 p.m., 7 p.m., 8 p.m. and 9.30 p.m.;

(b) by omitting from Regulation 75A (c) the matter "9 p.m." and by inserting instead the matter "9.30 p.m.".
