REGULATION**

(Authorising the release of information about inaccurate odometers)

**Commencement**

**1.** This Regulation commences on 14 September 1990.

**Amendment**

**2.** The Registration of Interests in Goods Regulation 1986 is amended by inserting after clause 5 (2) (c) the following paragraph:

(d) information received by the Commissioner that the odometer of a motor vehicle has been interfered with so that the reading of the odometer is incorrect.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Registration of Interests in Goods Regulation 1986 to enable the Commissioner for Consumer Affairs, if the Commissioner receives information that a vehicle odometer has been tampered with, to alert persons inquiring about the vehicle to that fact.
