**STATE AUTHORITIES SUPERANNUATION ACT 1987 -

(Relating to the formula for calculating the
periodic adjustment of certain pensions)

Commencement

1. This Regulation is to be taken to have commenced on 21 September 1989.

Amendment

2. The State Authorities Superannuation (Transitional Provisions) Regulation 1988 is amended by omitting the formula in clause 49 (1) (b) and by inserting instead the following formula:

$$P = \frac{100 (L - C)}{L}$$

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to amend the State Authorities Superannuation (Transitional Provisions) Regulation 1988 to rectify an error in the formula for calculating the percentage to be used for the periodic adjustment of certain pensions.
