Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 5 October 1990.

Amendment

2. The State Pollution Control Commission Regulation 1985 is amended by omitting from clause 3 (2) (b) the matter "\$42.10" and by inserting instead the matter "\$54.60".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The purpose of this Regulation is to amend the State Pollution Control Commission Regulation 1985 to increase the fee unit from \$42.10 to \$54.60. The Regulation prescribes fees for licences and renewals of licences under the State Pollution Control Commission Act 1970 in terms of numbers of fee units.
