I, Rear Admiral PETER ROSS SINCLAIR, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the Environmental Offences and Penalties (Amendment) Act 1990, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 January 1991 as the day on which that Act, except for:

- (a) Schedule 1(12); and
- (b) item (12) of the provisions of Schedule 2 relating to the Clean Air Act 1961; and
- (c) such part of item (12) of the provisions of Schedule 2 relating to the Clean Waters Act 1970 as repeals section 32A of that Act; and
- (d) the provisions of Schedule 2 relating to the Criminal Appeal Act 1912; and
- (e) items (4), (5), (6) and (7) of the provisions of Schedule 2 relating to the Justices Act 1902; and
- (f) the provisions of Schedule 2 relating to the Land and Environment Court Act 1979,
