Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 1 January 1991.

Amendment

2. The Clean Air Regulations 1964 are amended by omitting from each provision specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Regulation the matter specified in Column 2 of that Schedule and by inserting instead the matter specified in Column 3 of that Schedule.
