**PRIVATE HOSPITALS AND DAY PROCEDURE CENTRES
ACT 1988—REGULATION**

(Relating to fees)

Commencement

1. This Regulation takes effect on 21 December 1990.

Amendments

2. The Private Hospitals Regulation 1990 is amended:
 - (a) by omitting from clause 6 (b) the matter "\$450" and by inserting instead the matter "\$480";
 - (b) by omitting the table to clause 9 and by inserting instead the following table:

| 100 or more | \$3370 |

- (c) by omitting from clause 10 (b) the matter "\$450" and by inserting instead the matter "\$480".

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Private Hospitals Regulation 1990 to increase the following fees:

- application fees for licences;
 - annual licence fees;
 - application fees for the transfer of licences.
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
