**Commencement**

1. This Rule commences on 1 January 1991.

**Amendment**

2. The Local Courts (Civil Claims) Rules 1988 are amended by omitting rule 2 (5) of Part 2 and by inserting instead the following subrule:

(5) The fees to be paid to the registrar in respect of the business of the court are:

5.	For each copy of the transcript of any proceedings:	
	(a) per page where the matter being transcribed is under 3 months old .....	6.50
	(minimum fee for 1 to 8 pages) .....	55.00)
	(b) per page where the matter being transcribed is over 3 months old .....	7.50
	(minimum fee for 1 to 8 pages) .....	65.00)
6.	Service or attempted service by a bailiff of any process or other document, including service by post and preparation of affidavit of service .....	30.00
7.	Execution or attempted execution of a writ of execution or warrant to apprehend a Judgment debtor .....	40.00
8.	Where costs of insuring, conserving, or protecting property levied on or for advertising or preparing for sale are incurred, an amount equal to those costs.
