I, Rear Admiral PETER ROSS SINCLAIR, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the Miscellaneous Acts (Crown and Other Roads) Amendment Act 1990, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 April 1992 as the day on which that Act commences, except for the following:

- (a) item (2) of the amendments to the Land and Environment Court Act 1979 and the amendment to the Valuation of Land Act 1916 set out Schedule 1 to the Act;
- (b) section 3 of the Act in its application to those provisions.
