AMENDMENT ACT 1992 No. 9—PROCLAMATION**

I, Rear Admiral PETER ROSS SINCLAIR, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the Growth Centres (Development Corporations) Amendment Act 1992, do, by this my Proclamation:

- (a) appoint 31 March 1992 as the day on which the provisions of that Act (other than those to which paragraph (b) applies) commence;
- (b) appoint 1 May 1992 as the day on which the following provisions of Schedule 1 of that Act (and section 3 of that Act in its application to those provisions) commence:
 - item (1) (a) in its application to the Macarthur Development Corporation and the Macarthur Growth Area
 - item (1) (b)
 - item (1) (e)
 - item (9)
 - item (11)
 - item (13)
 - item (15)
 - item (16)
 - item (21) (b)
