EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the amendments to the Animal Research Act 1985 and the Exhibited Animals Protection Act 1986 contained in the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (No. 2) 1991. Those amendments

provide for the Director-General of the Department of Agriculture to take over the functions of the Director-General of the Department of Local Government and Co-operatives under the Animal Research Act 1985 and for the Director-General of the Department of Agriculture to take over the licensing, administrative and other functions that the Zoological Parks Board presently has under the Exhibited Animals Protection Act 1986.
