EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the amendments to the Pipelines Act 1967 contained in the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (No. 2) 1991.

These amendments:

- (a) modify the application procedures for permits and licences; and
