EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to insert the name of the Environment Protection Authority and the position of the Director-General of the Authority in Schedule 3 to the Public Finance and Audit Act 1983. The amendment will make the Authority subject to the obligations relating to the keeping of accounts and the inspection and audit of those accounts under Division 4A of Part 3 of the Act.
