EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Proclamation commences the remaining uncommenced provisions of the Workers Compensation (Benefits) Amendment Act 1991. The provisions contain amendments relating to the amount of excess that certain employers are required to repay to their insurers in respect of claims paid. The rest of the Act commenced on 1 February 1992.
