(Relating to the description of forecast totalizators)

Commencement

1. This Rule commences on 1st July, 1992.

Amendments

2. The Forecast Totalizator Rules 1968 are amended:
 - (a) by inserting after the words “Forecast Totalizator” in Rule 1 (f) the words “or “Exacta Totalizator” ”;
 - (b) by omitting the words “the Forecast totalizator” from Rule 1 (f) and by inserting instead the words “a forecast totalizator or an Exacta totalizator”;
 - (c) by inserting after the word “Forecast” wherever occurring in Rule 1 (j) the words “or “Exacta” ”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The purpose of this Rule is to enable the expression “Exacta totalizator” to be used to refer to a forecast totalizator.
