EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the amendments to the Western Lands Act 1901 contained in Schedule 1 to the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1992. The amendments relate to the positions of Western Lands Commissioner and an Assistant Western Lands Commissioner and provide for those positions to be subject to the Public Sector Management Act 1988.
