EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the remaining uncommenced provision of the Superannuation Legislation (Amendment) Act 1991 which contains an amendment that substitutes section 33B of the Superannuation Act 1916. The new section 33B relates to the manner in which the State Authorities Superannuation Board apportions the benefit between the contributors' reserve and the appropriate employer reserve.
