

IRRIGATION ACT 1912—REGULATION

(Relating to the Coleambally and Tullakool irrigation areas)

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 1 July 1992.

Amendment of Irrigation Areas (Water Supply) Regulation 1991

2. The Irrigation Areas (Water Supply) Regulation 1991 is amended by omitting from clause 3 the words “other than the Coleambally irrigation area and the Tullakool irrigation area”.

Repeals

3. The following regulations are repealed:
 - Coleambally (Supply of Water for Irrigation) Regulations
 - Coleambally (Supply of Water for Special Purposes) Regulations
 - Tullakool (Supply of Water) Regulations

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The objects of this Regulation are:

- (a) to extend the operation of the Irrigation Areas (Water Supply) Regulation 1991 to the Coleambally and Tullakool irrigation areas; and
- (b) to repeal certain regulations that currently apply to those irrigation areas.

This Regulation is made in connection with the staged repeal of subordinate legislation under the Subordinate Legislation Act 1989.
