The Maritime Services Board of New South Wales, in pursuance of the Maritime Services Act 1935, hereby makes the following Regulation:

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 1 August 1992.

Amendment

2. The Water Traffic Regulations—N.S.W. are amended by omitting from the Regulation specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this clause the matter specified opposite that Regulation in Column 2 of that Schedule and by inserting instead the matter specified opposite that Regulation in Column 3 of that Schedule.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Water Traffic Regulations—
N.S.W.:

- (a) to increase certain fees for an aquatic licence; and
- (b) to increase the fee for the registration of a registrable vessel; and
- (c) to increase the fee for a general or commercial licence to navigate at speed;
and
- (d) to increase the fee for a duplicate licence to navigate at speed.
