EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the Corporations (New South Wales) Amendment Act 1991 (namely the provisions of Schedule 1 (1) (b) and (c), (3)–(11) and (13), section 3 in its application to them and section 4). Those provisions:

- (a) amend the Corporations (New South Wales) Act 1990 for the purpose of conferring certain jurisdiction on the Family Court of Australia and State Family Courts; and

- (b) repeal the National Companies and Securities Commission (State Provisions) Act 1981 as a consequence of the abolition of the National Companies and Securities Commission.
