EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the amendments to the Education (Ancillary Staff) Act 1987 contained in the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1992. The amendments designate the Director-General of School Education as the employer, for industrial purposes, of ancillary staff in the Department of School Education and give effect to other minor statute law revision.
