**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the amendments to the Fines and Forfeited Recognizances Act 1954 contained in the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1992. The amendments enable a form of notice under the 1954 Act to be approved by the Minister instead of being prescribed by regulations, update obsolete references in that Act and remove an obsolete provision of that Act.
