TRAFFIC ACT 1909—REGULATION

(Relating to the special speed limit for learner drivers and riders)

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 1st September, 1992.

Amendment

2. The Motor Traffic Regulations 1935 are amended by omitting from Regulation 124 (3C) (a) the matter “70 km/h” and by inserting instead the matter “80 km/h”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Motor Traffic Regulations to increase the special speed limit applied to learner drivers and riders from 70 km/h to 80 km/h.
