**SECOND-HAND DEALERS AND COLLECTORS ACT 1906—
REGULATION**

(Excluding certain goods from the operation of the Act)

HIS Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of the Second-hand Dealers and Collectors Act 1906, has been pleased to make the Regulation set forth hereunder.

The Seventh Schedule to the Second-hand Dealers and Collectors Act 1906 is amended by inserting after paragraph (l) the following paragraph:

(m) Second-hand clothing, other than furs and leathers.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to exempt dealers in second-hand clothing (other than furs and leathers) from compliance with the provisions of the Second-hand Dealers and Collectors Act 1906 in relation to that clothing. This is achieved by adding to the list of goods excluded from the Act's definition of "second-hand goods".
