**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

Section 58 of the Public Sector Executives Superannuation Act 1989 empowers the Governor to make an order amending Schedule 1 by inserting the name of the position of an employee. Such an employee can elect to become a member of the Public Sector Executives Superannuation Fund. The object of this Order is to insert the names of positions of certain executives of the Shortland County Council.
