**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

Section 58 of the Public Sector Executives Superannuation Act 1889 empowers the Governor to make an order mending Schedule 1 by inserting the name of an employer and the names of the positions of employees. Such employees can elect to become members of the Public Sector Executives Superannuation Fund.

The object of this Order is to:

- insert the name of the Government Pricing Tribunal as an employer in Schedule 1; and
- insert the names of positions of certain executives of the Tribunal as employees.
