**CHIROPRACTORS AND OSTEOPATHS ACT 1991—
REGULATION**

(Relating to fees)

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 28 February 1993.

Amendments

2. The Chiropractors and Osteopaths Regulation 1991 is amended:

- by omitting from clause 13 (b) the matter “\$100” and by inserting instead the matter “\$124”;
- by omitting from clause 14 (1) the matter “\$200” and by inserting instead the matter “\$248”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Chiropractors and Osteopaths Regulation 1991 to increase certain fees relating to:

- the annual roll fee payable by practitioners; and
- the restoration of a practitioner’s name to one of the registers.
