EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence most of the Lotto (Amendment) Act 1992. The amendments not commenced by this Proclamation relate to certain amendments about key employees (e.g. recasting the definition of "key employee") and to the disposal of money in certain licensees' prize funds.
