**WASTE DISPOSAL ACT 1970—REGULATION**

(Relating to contributions payable for waste disposal)

**Commencement**

**1.** This Regulation commences on 1 January 1993.

**Amendments**

**2.** The Waste Management Authority Depot Contribution Regulations 1971 are amended:

(a) by omitting Regulation 1 (1) and by inserting instead the following clause:

(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Waste Disposal (Depot Contributions) Regulations 1971.

(b) by omitting from Regulation 3 (1) the matter “\$2.80” and by inserting instead the matter “\$4.20”.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The purpose of this Regulation is to amend the Waste Management Authority Depot Contribution Regulations 1971 made under the Waste Disposal Act 1970 so as:

- (a) to change the citation of the Regulations to the Waste Disposal (Depot Contributions) Regulations 1978 to reflect 1991 amendments to the waste Disposal Act 1970 abolishing the Waste Management Authority; and
- (b) to increase (from \$2.80 to \$4.20) the contribution payable to the Environment Protection Authority by the occupier of a depot for each tonne of waste transported into the depot for treatment, storage or disposal.
