The Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Investment Powers Regulation 1990 is amended by inserting in Schedule 2 in alphabetical order the words “New South Wales Lotteries”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Section 24 of the Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Act 1987 (“the PAFA Act”) enables regulations to be made conferring on corporations constituted by or under an Act certain investment powers listed in Part 2 of Schedule 4 to the PAFA Act.

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Investment Powers Regulation 1990 so as to confer on New South Wales Lotteries those investment powers.
