I, Rear Admiral PETER ROSS SINCLAIR, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the Electricity and Other Legislation (Amendment) Act 1991, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 March 1992 as the day on which that Act, except for:

- (a) the provisions of Schedule 1 (10) and (11); and
- (b) the provisions of Schedule 1 (12), in relation only to proposed section 29 (1) of the Electricity Act 1945; and
- (c) the provisions of Schedule 2 relating to the Search Warrants Act 1985,

commences.
