EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Proclamation commences the provisions of the Auctioneers and Agents (Amendment) Act 1992 that:

- create new classes of licences and registrations under the Auctioneers and Agents Act 1941
- change the name of that Act to the Property, Stock and Business Agents Act 1941
- empower licensees under that Act to share commission with persons licensed under a corresponding Act of a State or Territory.
