Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 1 June 1993

- (a) by omitting from Part 1 of Schedule 5 (Fees) the following matter:

Grant of opal prospecting licence (Sec. 228)	\$210
- (b) by omitting from Part 2 of Schedule 5 the following matter:

Application for suspension of conditions of mineral claim (Cl. 43)	\$25

and by inserting instead the following matter:

Application for suspension of conditions of mineral claim
(Cl. 43) \$35

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Mining (General) Regulation 1992 to increase the fees for the renewal, transfer, transfer by devolution and application for suspension of conditions of mineral claims, and for the grant of opal prospecting licences.
