EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Legal Aid Commission (Amendment) Bill 1992 amends the Legal Aid Commission Act 1992, to remove the requirement that the chief executive of the Commission be a practising solicitor, to change the title of the chief executive officer from "Director" to "Managing Director", and to make certain consequential amendments.
