**STATE AUTHORITIES NON-CONTRIBUTORY
SUPERANNUATION ACT 1987—ORDER**

I, Rear Admiral PETER ROSS SINCLAIR, A.C., Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 27 of the State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Act 1987, do, by this my Order, amend Schedule 1 to that Act (Employers), with effect on and from 4 February 1993, by inserting at the end of Part 1 of that Schedule the following name and limitation:

Australian Industrial Registry (limited to those persons:

- (a) who on 3 February 1993 were employed by the Joint Coal Board constituted under the Coal Industry Act 1946 as officers of the Coal Industry Tribunal also constituted under that Act; and
- (b) who, before becoming employed in the Australian Industrial Registry, have not requested the Board to pay their basic benefits to another superannuation scheme).
