EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to appoint 1 August 1993 as the commencement date of the Trustee (Amendment) Act 1993. The Act enables a trustee to make use of the Reserve Bank Information and Transfer System to hold or invest in securities which the trustee is authorised to hold or invest in.
