JUSTICES ACT 1902—REGULATION

(Relating to short descriptions of certain offences under the Local Government Act 1993)

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 1 August 1993.

Amendment

2. The Justices (Short Descriptions of Local Government Offences) Regulation 1993 is amended by inserting in Schedule 1 in appropriate order the following matter:

Section 630 (1)—without lawful excuse, break a bottle, glass, glass receptacle or syringe on public land or a public road

break bottle/glass/
syringe/glass receptacle
on public land/road

Section 630 (2)—throw, place, leave on public land or a public road any bottle, glass, glass receptacle, syringe, broken glass or other matter or thing likely to endanger safety of or cause injury to any person or animal or damage to any vehicle or property

throw/place/leave on public
land/road matter/thing
likely to endanger/injure
person/animal/likely to
damage vehicle/property

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe the short descriptions that, by virtue of section 145B of the Justices Act 1902, are sufficient to state or describe, in any information, complaint, summons, warrant, notice, order or other document, certain offences under the Local Government Act 1993.
