(Relating to fees for terminating strata schemes)

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 2 August 1993.

Amendment

2. The Strata Titles Regulations 1974 are amended by inserting in Regulation 52 after item 8 the following item:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Strata Titles Regulations 1974 to allow the Registrar-General to charge fees on the lodgment and investigation of an application made under section 51A of the Act for an order to terminate a strata scheme.

This Regulation is made under the Strata Titles Act 1973, including section 158 (the general regulation-making power).
